In Phase 2, our strategic work was for every CMFI member to obey the Santa Cruz Prophecy. And God sustained us. The strategy worked. We began in a terrible spiritual condition, but those who obeyed the Santa Cruz Prophecy entered the circle of "who's who" in CMFI, like Paul Bello and many others. On the other hand, some of the wonderful men of God who have been in our ministry over the past 40 years, but who have not obeyed the Santa Cruz Prophecy, have continued to fade away.

God has led us to Phase 3 and called us to discipleship in the context of house churches. He has called us to have house churches that are disciple-making centres. God is calling us to make disciples with a training programme, the Bertoua Message, within the framework of house churches. If we want to do strategic work, we need to get back to our thinking, as well as doing the work of making disciples. Our thinking, our programmes, our institutions and our ministry must be managed according to discipleship paradigms.

If there are super spiritual people among us who do not return to house churches and who do not obey the Bertoua message, we have seven years ahead of us. They will find themselves on the periphery of the ministry, just as many great leaders who have not obeyed the Santa Cruz Prophecy are presently on the periphery of the ministry. God builds with those who obey. Whatever your position, whatever your title, if we do not return to house churches and this simple growth programme that we have been given, I would like to promise you, without hating you, that you have seven years to be on the outskirts of this ministry, whoever and whatever you are now.

God has given us a normalization programme. He has given us a growth programme, whose context and unity are the house church. This is our strategic work in the current situation.

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PREFACE


Beloved,



LESSON 1: WHO REALLY IS A DISCIPLE?

Course Material: The Book *MAKING OF DISCIPLES* by Professor Zacharias Tanee Fomum.

Section of the book to read: Chapter 1 of the book *MAKING OF DISCIPLES.*

Goal: To lead the believer to confront the nine (9) conditions for being and remaining a disciple of the Lord Jesus.

Summary: The disciple is a person who has forsaken all sin and made a total commitment to the Lord Jesus. To be and to remain a disciple of the Lord Jesus, the believer must love the Lord with supreme love (love him with all his spirit, with all his soul and with all his body). From this supreme love for the Lord flows a supreme love for all the brethren, the separation from the family, from the 'self,' the carrying of one's cross, renouncing everything, abiding in the word and bearing fruit.

- **N.B:** For greater efficiency, it is strongly recommended to stick to the strict reading of the prescribed portion of the book in which the answers to the questions asked are found.

Women also as disciples have the responsibility to make disciples in order to obey the Lord's command to all disciples to go and make disciples of the Lord of all nations.
