He thus started the Bible camps in December 2009, organized the youth and student ministry, set up an international secretariat to coordinate the activities among the youths worldwide and appointed Brother Joseph Ngandeu to assist him in this department.

In 2015, in order to increase the production, and to enhance the productivity of young co-workers, and so to quicken the accomplishment of the vision, Brother Theodore Andoseh set up the University Spiritual Province (USP) to conquer the students for Christ.
